Blueberries \$10	One Gallon Containers. At least two varieties should be planted together.
Brightwell	Ripens early to mid June- mid July. Vigorous/upright. Medium size. Great flavor. Pollinates with Powder Blue.
Pink Lemonade	Sweet fruit, bright pink when ripe. Self Pollinating. Ripens late Summer. Mild taste.
Powder Blue	Late season ripening, highly productive with medium- large sweet fruit, darker in color. Pollinates with Tifblue.
Titan	Late season ripening, large berry, excellent flavor, high yields. Pollinate with Powder Blue.
Muscadines \$10	One Gallon Containers. Self Fertile.
Lane	Large black fruit, ripens early, excellent firmness and flavor.
Magnolia	Bronze, early, medium to large size, excellent fresh flavor.
Noble	Small black fruit, large clusters, high yields, ripens mid season.
Triumph	Bronze large fruit, good flavor, large clusters, good yields.
Figs \$10	One Gallon Containers. Self Fertile.
LSU Purple	Fruit is medium in size, purple skin, good flavor.
Magnolia	Large, hollow fruit that are light brown with darker ribs. Good for processing and canning.
Blackberries \$10	One Gallon Containers. Blackberries are thornless. Self Fertile.
Arapaho	Mid season ripens 2 weeks earlier than Navaho; Fruit is good quality medium size.
Navajo	Late season ripening, sweetest, small berry.
Natchez	Early season, semi-erect variety with large, sweet blackberries. High yields.
Ouachita	Mid season ripening, large in size, high yields. Very good flavor.
Apple Trees \$30	Five Gallon Containers- Two varieties needed to ensure cross pollination.
Honey Crisp	Fruit is mottled red over yellow ground color. Very crisp flesh. Excellent eating and keeping apple.
Jona Gold	Fruit are large with striped red over bright yellow, firm, crisp, juicy and slightly tart. Pollinate w/ Red Delicious.
Pink Lady	Fruit are large with pink skin over green. Snappy tartness and crisp, sweet flavor. ripens late September.
Red Delicious	Fruit are large in size. Dark red skin, crisp, juicy and ripen mid-season.
Callaway Crabapple	Beautiful tree and great for pollinating all of your apple varieties. (Pollinator)
Pear Tree \$30	Five Gallon Containers- Two varieties needed to ensure cross pollination.
Bartlett	Fruit are large in size, yellowish brown in color, white flesh, very sweet, juicy, and ripen mid-season.
Moonglow	Fruit are medium in size, yellow in color, white flesh, soft, and ripen early. Mild flavor with almost no grit cells.
Pecan Trees \$50	Five Gallon Containers- Two varieties needed to ensure cross pollination.
Caddo	Produces at an early age. Medium-thin thickness.
Cape Fear	Produces at an early age. A large nut, fills out well, and an average bearer. Originated in NC.
Plum \$30	Five Gallon Containers- Two varieties needed to ensure cross pollination.
Methley	Hardy, self-fertile, purple-red plums, sweet, good pollinator, fungal rust resistant.
Blue Damson	Small round, blue fruit. Tart green freestone flesh. Ripens late August to late September.
Byrongold	This tree is perfect for the South. Large, bright, yellow fruit. Golden yellow flesh. Ripens late June - early July.
Peach \$30	Five Gallon Containers- Self Pollinating
Harvester	Produces throughout Summer. Highest yielding tree available. Very juicy. Yellow/red blush skin, yellow flesh.
Elberta	Produces mid-late Summer (less frost sensitive); Favorite yellow variety, especially for local market.
O'Henry	Large yellow freestone peach. Excellent flavor. Fruit is firm, yellow flesh.
